

Colville Delegates Re-elected

NESPELEM — Councilmen endorsed by the Colville Liquidation Promoters continued to maintain their 10-4 majority on the Colville Business council after the May 6 general elections for the council.

All seven candidates elected were incumbents. Five of these had been endorsed by the CLP.

Narcisse Nicholson, jr., present chairman from the Omak district, was re-elected to his third 2-year term. Nicholson is presently serving his third successive term as chairman of the council.

A TOTAL of 1111 certified votes were cast. Of these, 576 voted by absentee ballot.

The candidates elected who were favored by the CLP were Nicholson; Thelma Marchand, Omak district; Dean Bourgeau, Inchelium district; Alice Lawrence, Inchelium district; and Barney Rickard of the Keller district.

Also elected were Frank George and Shirley Palmer of the Nespelem district. Complete returns from the districts were:

The business council has 14 members representing the four districts. Each year seven of the councilmen's 2-year terms expire.
