Mr. MAGNUSON (for himself and Mr. JACKSON) (by request) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs

A BILL

To amend certain provisions of the Act of July 24, 1956, relating to the restoration of tribal ownership of certain lands upon the Colville Indian Reservation, Washington.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That (a) section 2 of the Act entitled "An Act restoring
4 to tribal ownership certain lands upon the Colville Indian
5 Reservation, Washington, and for other purposes", approved
6 July 24, 1956 (70 Stat. 626), is amended by deleting "In
7 carrying out the provisions of this Act, if non-Indian lands
8 are involved the board of county commissioners of counties
9 in which land is located shall by proper resolution consent

1 before such non-Indian land is acquired for the tribe or an
2 individual Indian.”.

3 (b) Sections 4 and 5 of such Act of July 24, 1956, are
4 hereby repealed.
